SEALED BIDS will be received at the offices of the District at 1600 Aloha Place, Oceano, CA 93445 until 2:00 p.m. local time, 05/22/2017 and promptly thereafter all Bids that have been duly received will be publicly opened and read aloud for furnishing to said District all labor, materials, equipment, transportation, services and supplies necessary to construct and complete the construction of the

CHERRY AVENUE PIPE BRIDGE MAINTENANCE PROJECT

Construction of the SSLOCSD CHERRY AVENUE PIPE BRIDGE MAINTENANCE PROJECT, consists of:

- Remove vegetation and trim trees that obstruct access to the pipe bridge;
- Construction of a containment system that fully contains all material removed from the pipe bridge, and any debris and/or hazardous material that is generated during removal of the existing coatings and the application of new coatings. This containment system will be suspended from the existing pipe bridge;
- Expose at least 12 inches of the buried portion of the carrier pipe at both ends of the bridge structure, remove the existing coating where needed and re-coat with a wax tape and fiberglass outer wrap system, and re-bury the pipe;
- Perform spot repair to certain portions of the existing coating system on structural steel members of the bridge and re-coat with either a wax tape and fiberglass outer wrap system or a 3-layer modified polyamidoamine epoxy/aliphatic acrylic polyurethane coating system;
- Repair the access gates on the existing end barriers;
- Comply with all environmental regulations and project-specific requirements;
- and all work necessary to render the facility complete and operational.

Requests for information or clarification must be submitted IN WRITING and received by the District no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, 05/15/2017 (Monday before bid opening). Requests may be submitted via email to: rreilly@garingtaylor.com

The Design Engineer has calculated an estimate of probable construction costs for this project. The District does not wish to publicize the engineer's estimate of the project cost because this information may tend to influence the number and nature of bids received. However, for the bidder's convenience, the District will publicize that the engineer's estimate for the base bid falls within a range of \$149,000 and \$249,000.

Bids shall be executed on the forms provided in the book of bidding documents and in accordance with the instructions contained therein. A separate, unbound, set of bid forms are provided for the bidder's convenience.



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Bid security, in an amount not less than 10 percent (10%) of the total bid dollar amount, is required to be submitted with each bid. The bid security shall be in the form of a bidder's bond or a certified or cashier's check drawn upon a responsible bank made payable to SSLOCSD, and conditioned to be forfeited to said District in the event that the bidder, if the bid is accepted, does not enter into a written contract within ten (10) days after the awarding of the contract. The bidder to whom award is made will be required to furnish a payment bond and a faithful performance bond.

As required under Contractor's License in the Instructions to Bidders of the bidding documents, bidders shall be licensed as a Class "A" General Engineering Contractor.

In addition, the following conditions apply:

- No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project (submitted on or after March 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].
- No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project (awarded on or after April 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.
- This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

Pursuant to Section 1770, and the following, of the California Labor Code, the successful bidder shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. A copy of such prevailing rate of per diem wages is on file at the offices of the District at 1600 Aloha Place, Oceano, CA 93445, which copy will be made available for examination at such offices during business hours to any party on request.

Pursuant to provisions of Section 22300 of the California Public Contract Code, Contractor may substitute securities for any monies withheld by Owner to ensure performance of the Work.

A MANDATORY job-walk and pre-bid conference WILL be held for this project at the job site, located behind 410 W Branch St, Arroyo Grande, CA 93420, at 9:00 AM on Monday, May 15, 2017. Potential Bidders should park on the street. No off-street parking will be provided.
