

## NOTICE INVITING BIDS

### SOUTH SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT, CA

SEALED BIDS will be received at the offices of the District at 1600 Aloha Place, Oceano, CA 93445 until

**2:00 p.m., January 23, 2020**

at which time they will be publicly opened and read for performing work as follows:

Construction of the SSLOCSD PRIMARY CLARIFIER NO. 2 REHABILITATION AND COATING PROJECT, consists of:

- Removal and disposal of existing Clarifier No. 2 Mechanism
- Installation of Owner furnished new Clarifier Mechanism
- Sandblast and coating of clarifier mechanism and sandblast and coating of concrete launder, scum box and Effluent Box.

Electronic Drawings, specifications and other bidding documents can be requested from the Cannon Engineers at 805-544-7407. Planholder contact information will be collected and then a link to the drawings will be provided. Contractors will be responsible for printing the Plans and Specifications.

OBTAINING CONTRACT DOCUMENTS: The Contract Documents are entitled "SOUTH SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICT PRIMARY CLARIFIER NO. 2 REHABILITATION AND COATINGS PROJECT." The Contract Documents may be obtained from CANNON Engineers by requesting an Electronic Copy. Contact Susan Harris at 805-544-7407 for placement onto the Planholders list and for login information to the Project Plans and Specifications. You may also walk into Cannon office at 1050 Southwood Drive, San Luis Obispo for a printed set at a cost of \$35.

Requests for information or clarification must be submitted **IN WRITING** and received by the District no later than 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 20, 2020 (**Monday before bid opening**). The Design Engineer has calculated an estimate of probable construction costs for this project. The District does not wish to publicize the engineer's estimate of the project cost since this information may tend to influence the number and nature of bids received. However, for the bidder's convenience, the District will publicize that the engineer's estimate for the base bid falls within a range of \$200,000.

Bids shall be executed on the forms provided in the book of bidding documents and in accordance with the instructions contained therein. A separate, unbound, set of bid forms are provided for the bidder's convenience.

Bid security, in an amount not less than 10 percent (10%) of the total bid dollar amount, is required to be submitted with each bid. The bid security shall be in the form of a bidder's bond or a certified or cashier's check drawn upon a responsible bank made payable to SSLOCSD, and conditioned to be forfeited to said District in the event that the bidder, if the bid is accepted, does not enter into a written contract within ten (10) days after the awarding of the contract. The bidder to whom award is made will be required to furnish a payment bond and a faithful performance bond.

As required under Contractor's License in the Instructions to Bidders of the bidding documents, bidders shall be licensed as a Class "A" General Engineering Contractor.

In addition, the following conditions apply:

- No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project (submitted on or after March 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].
- No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project (awarded on or after April 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.
- This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

Pursuant to Section 1770, and the following, of the California Labor Code, the successful bidder shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. A copy of such prevailing rate of per diem wages is on file at the offices of the District at 1600 Aloha Place, Oceano, CA 93445, which copy will be made available for examination at such offices during business hours to any party on request.

Pursuant to provisions of Section 22300 of the California Public Contract Code, Contractor may substitute securities for any monies withheld by Owner to ensure performance of the Work.

A MANDATORY pre-bid conference WILL be held on January 7th, 2020 at 9 am at 1600 Aloha Place for this project.

SSLOCSD reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive all minor irregularities.
